You can sign up online for an eCard that will give you remote access to our electronic collections, such as: e-books & audiobooks, movies, tv, digital magazines, music, and databases.

eCards are available to anyone who lives, resides part-time to attend school, owns property, or works in Massachusetts.

eCards expire every 2 years, but are renewable online. An eCard can be upgraded to a BPL card with borrowing privileges by visiting a BPL location with photo ID and proof of a MA address.


